Redbridge Matters, a community social action group is seeking an independent prospective parliamentary candidate for Ilford South to stand in the next General Election 2024.

The candidate must:

- Reside in Redbridge.
- Be willing to undertake and realise the aims and objectives of Redbridge Matters.
- Be willing to commit fully to an election campaign and undertake all activities leading up to the general election date.

It would be preferable for the candidate to:

- have significant experience of voluntary work, community activism, campaigning on local issues and resident engagement.
- demonstrate leadership and have ability to inspire others to action and civic participation.
- have excellent communication, public speaking skills and the ability to connect with people.
- have a good understanding of local and national issues including housing, NHS, public services, crime, social justice etc.
- have experience/understanding of political affairs both national and international and laws related to General Elections, expenses, and other regulatory requirements.
- have a good understanding of the UK legislations related to equality and human rights.

All applicants are requested to submit:

- A full curriculum vitae including 2 referees (one current employer)
- A 2-minute video on why you are the best candidate for Ilford South
- Personal statement outlining how you meet the criterion (1-page A4 maximum)
- Any letter/bill to verify residency in Redbridge.
